
Most of the funds raised stay locally for the many great projects listed in this program. We are not a 501(c)3 but operate under the umbrella of the national organization.

The SDYHA is starting their 10th year with over 70 matches. Currently, we take boys and girls ages 12-17 on mentored hunts - primarily mentored doe hunts. However, we



encourage ANY outdoor activities that the mentor and/or mentee is interested in. We have a 2nd chapter in the Northern Hills and we are in the process of starting a 3rd chapter in Mitchell SD. Our board is mostly comprised of individuals who are also active in other conservation groups - and the SCI Greater Dakotah Chapter is represented on our board. Because of these relationships with local conservation groups, we are provided with both financial means and mentors who are willing to take a child hunting. The kids we are working with most likely would never experience the outdoors if it wasn't for this program.

We partner with the Big Brothers/Big Sisters of the Black Hills to make appropriate matches. Each child is required to take Hunt Safe. We have a group range day to go over safety and the proper handling of firearms. All necessary gear is provided for these kids - even the meat processing. We teach the importance of respect for landowners, conservation, and fair chase. We are finding that after age 18, 26% of our kids are purchasing some sort of license via SD GFP.

We truly feel that our program is like no other. We are starting to gain national attention inquiring how this program can be replicated in other areas. We are not only encouraging future sportsmen and women, but also providing the carrot for positive role models for kids that don't have it. SAFARI CARE™

"BLUE BAG BRIGADE"

SafariCare™ is a volunteer healthcare and humanitarian outreach program serving people in need in remote communities around the globe. It does this mainly through the shipment of medical, educational, hygiene and other relief supplies, clothing and toys to locations hunters are going already. This program began through the efforts of a few innovative members, who in 1996, came up with a simple formula: when traveling, you generally take less luggage than the airlines allow, so why not take an extra bag, a **Blue Bag**. One extra baggage item taken on safari has an impact upon the local community your travelling to that is priceless. Today a network of local SCI chapters exists, who together have delivered these bags personally to doctors, teachers and villagers to utilize locally at clinics, schools, orphanages or the local village. These SCI hunters are seen as SCI heroes in the people's eyes and assuredly the good feelings go both ways. The Greater Dakotah Chapter **has three Blue Bags** available for use, and our members have delivered these well received items to the locals of Namibia, South Africa, Mexico, Texas and Argentina.

The Greater Dakotah Chapter invites you to borrow one of the Blue Bags (or more!) for use during your next safari. The **Blue Bag** can be filled with items (such as aspirin, first aid kits, imperishable food items, clothing, toys and games, water purification tablets, or adhesive bandages and ointments) either personally or by contacting local health care providers and department stores for donations. By contacting local and international airlines/carriers, participants in this program can be sure their extra baggage meets guidelines, can get assistance with scheduling their trips, and can encourage the airline to forgive or drastically reduce the costs for the extra baggage. The professional hunter associated with your safari is a great resource in determining the best candidate for your **Blue Bag**, and will usually provide assistance with facilitating the delivery and distribution of the items. Once you return home, simply return the **Blue Bag** to a chapter board member for washing and subsequent use by other members.






